

MRSA CLINIC OF MISSISSIPPI INTRODUCTION

1. Please fill out the first page of the MRSA history and then print off the CIDE history and fill it out completely.
2. It is very important to bring a list of your cultures and antibiotics and decolonization attempts and their results over the past 24 months.
3. You need to talk with family members and other intimate personal contacts to see if they have had any boils. If so attempt to obtain their records.
4. If MRSA has entered your home, other family members may be carrying it without showing signs of infection. When you come for your visit, bring as many of your household members as possible so that they may be cultured. They do not all need the same extent of workup. Eventually they will all have to be cultured, and we need to stop the epidemic in your family as soon as possible. Complete evaluation of all family members at risk is the foundation of this treatment plan.
